

Senior Dues

There are some of you who still owe Senior Dues!

Dues are now \$100. You can pay through PaySchools. If paying with a check make it payable to “Class of 2012.” Write the Student’s Name and “Senior Dues” in the Memo Line. Place the check in an envelope labeled “Senior Dues” and place it in the drop box in the Main Office.

If dues are not paid by March 15th your yearbook will not be personalized. If they are not paid by April 10th, you may not be able to attend Senior Prom. If they are not paid by June 8th, you may not be able to walk in graduation and you will not receive your diploma until your dues have been paid.

ALL FINES MUST BE PAID BEFORE TICKETS CAN BE PURCHASED. This includes senior dues, book fines, and library fines. A list of students who owe book and library fines will be posted outside of the cafeteria in February. You should have received a letter in the mail if you owe senior dues.

If you are bringing a date from another school you must completed the attached form (see page 4) and bring a copy of your guest's Drivers License or School ID. **You cannot purchase tickets without these!**

Sun Valley High School Student-Guest Permission Form
Class of 2012 Senior Prom on Friday, May 4th from 7 p.m. to 11 p.m.

This form must be completed and submitted along with a photocopy of a picture ID of your guest (school ID or Driver's License) to your class advisor at the time of ticket purchase. Forms and copies of IDs will not be accepted after ticket sales have ended. Guests will not be permitted entrance if this form and a picture ID are not submitted in the prescribed timeframe.

Expectations for School-sponsored Dances/Proms:

- Students must be at the dance by **7:30 p.m.**
- All students may have to pass a breathalyzer upon entering the dance. Students found under the influence of alcohol or drugs will be subject to the disciplinary consequences.
- All bags may be searched upon entrance.
- Sun Valley is not responsible for lost or stolen items. Personal items of significant value should not be brought to the dance.
- Students who choose to leave the dance before its conclusion will not be permitted re-entrance. Students may not leave before **10:30 p.m.** Refunds will not be given to students who do not show up or who leave early.
- Sun Valley students may bring only one guest. Guests will not be permitted entrance if the form is not submitted in the prescribed time-frame.
- All school rules apply during the dance.
