

Communication Chain

Communication is an essential part of the educational program. We feel it is very important for parents to keep in close contact with the child's teacher concerning student progress. Please do not hesitate to keep us aware of events that may be impacting your child's educational experience.

When a problem arises, it is important to make initial contact with the right person. *The following communication chain should be followed:*

- For classroom-based parental concerns: Parent > Teacher > Building Principal and Teacher
- For support personnel and bus, recess, cafeteria: Parent > Building Principal (support personnel as needed)
- For student behavior concerns related to classroom activity: Parent > Teacher > Principal
- For ongoing or significant behaviorial concerns affecting any element of the student's day: Parent > Building Principal

Communicate and Connect

Penn-Delco has incorporated multiple communication platforms to keep you and your family informed. This guide will direct you where to update your personal information, check grades, report attendance, review report cards, and communicate with teachers, principals, and other administrators. Thank you for taking the time to review our tools to keep everyone connected.



Skyward is the district's **student information management platform** which houses your child/children's personal information including family contact information and address(es), medical information (like allergy or other directives), attendance information, and report § K Y W A R D° cards. Contact information for phone, email, and text messaging may be updated by the child's guardian directly in the Skylert section

in Skyward. Other information is entered by your school. If you are new to Penn-Delco, you may log into to Skyward by going to the login page and use the 'Forgot username or password' link. It will ask for your email address. The system will then send your login info with a password reset link (if the email matches what we have on file in Skyward.) Your Skyward account username and password are the same throughout your time at Penn-Delco. No need to create a new account each school year. Go to pdsd.org/technology for more information.



Schoology is the *district's learning management platform* to foster collaboration and personalize learning. Schoology is Penn-Delco's resource for teachers, parents, club leaders, administrators, and students to assign, track, and submit

assignments as well as communicate and share plans and events. With a single account, parents can view all the courses and groups their children participate in, as well as any important information the teacher or club leader would like to share. Sun Valley High School and Northley Middle School parents can view and track students' grades, assignments, and important information the teacher would like to share. Elementary teachers use Schoology exclusively for communication. Go to **pdsd.org/technology** for more information.



SchoolMessenger Communicate is the *district's mass notification system* that is utilized to send mass communication to school and district formula communication to school and district families via voice, email, and text messaging. The contact preferences you

enter in **Skyward's Skylert** section for phone, email, and text preferences are synced nightly with **SchoolMessenger** to ensure you receive important communications from your principal or superintendent. While you may also be contacted by teachers via **Schoology** or email (**Outlook**), larger, batched communication comes through the **SchoolMessenger Communicate** platform.

While you may have entered your preferred numbers for text messaging in the **Skyward Skylert** section, you must be opted into text messaging to receive SMS texts. If you haven't already, opt in to the SchoolMessenger SMS text system by texting "Y" or "Yes" to our district short code 67587. If you would like to opt out of the system, text "STOP" to the same short code. You will be removed from text messaging.

Now it is easier than ever to report absences in Penn-Delco. Our *SchoolMessenger SafeArrival* absence reporting is open 24 hours per day, 7 days a week to report ahead of time (and serves as your absence note if you report before 11am on the day of the absence). *Absences should be reported before the official school day begins to prevent the system from contacting you to confirm an absence*. Make sure your contact information, including phone numbers and email addresses, is updated and accurate in the Skylert section of Skyward to ensure absence reporting is accurate and easy.



SchoolMessenger SafeArrival

SchoolMessenger SafeArrival is the district absence reporting system that offers three convenient ways to report your child's absence.

- Using your mobile device, download and install the **SchoolMessenger** app from the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store (or from the links at go.schoolmessenger.com). The first time you use the app, select Sign Up to create your account. Select Attendance then Report an Absence.

Use the **SafeArrival SchoolMessenger** website, **go.schoolmessenger.com**. The first time you use the website, select **Sign Up** to create your account. **Select Attendance** then **Report an Absence**.



Call the toll-free number (888) 635-0460 to report an absence using the automated phone system. This number is the same attendance reporting number for all Penn-Delco Schools.

Please note that if you use either the mobile app, or the website, your username and password are the same. You can use any of these three options at any time. These options are available 24 hours/day, 7 days a week and future absences can be reported at any time. You must, however, report your child's absence before 11am to prevent the system from contacting you and to be excused from providing a written absence note.

The **SchoolMessenger Communicate** automated notification system will contact parents/guardians whose child is absent when the absence is not reported in advance (before the school day begins). The automated notification system will attempt to contact parents at their preferred contact points for a reason for the absence. If you report your child's absence in advance using the SafeArrival toll-free number, website, or mobile app, you will NOT receive these notifications. Our principals choose to offer weekly or monthly newsletters to families *created in our Constant Contact platform*. Contact information is also synced with our **Skyward Skylert** system for the most up- to-date email preferences. The district also sends a monthly email newsletter via Constant Contact.









Safe2Say Something is a youth violence prevention program run by the Pennsylvania Office of Attorney General. The program teaches youth and adults how to recognize warning signs and signals, especially within social media, from individuals who may be a threat to themselves or others and to "say something" BEFORE it is too late. Health Services

Your school nurse is a unique specialist whose primary role is to strengthen the educational process through improvement of the health status of children and young people. Your nurse is a registered professional nurse with at least a baccalaureate degree and certified by the Pennsylvania Department of Education. Penn-Delco nurses have an extensive background in health care, health education, school health and the use of community resources. Some of the services provided include health screenings, medical and dental examinations, emergency care, medication administration, maintenance of student health records, and monitoring of immunization compliance.

Spend time on our **Health Services** section by typing in **pdsd.org/healthservices** to familiarize yourself with our nurse directory, health requirements (schedules and forms), illness procedures and support, fifth grade "changing" videos, and links to health resources.

Physical and Dental Exam Requirements

The Pennsylvania School Health Act requires a medical examination for *every student starting school in grade K or 1, grade 6, and grade 11.*If your school nurse currently does not have a recent updated physical form on record for your child, you can have the physical examination done by your family physician. We encourage you to have the physical completed by your family physician and submit the form to your school nurse.

We recommend having your child see your own private dentist every 6 months. Dental forms are required by the Pennsylvania School Code for school entry *Kindergarten (K)* and grade one (1) and grades three (3) and seven (7). Please submit the completed dental form to the school nurse at the beginning of your child's Kindergarten/first grade, third grade, and seventh grade school years. **Physical and dental forms can be found at pdsd.org/healthservices.**

Lunch is an important part of the day in Penn-Delco. We are pleased to offer our students a relaxed environment for them to socialize and enjoy a meal. Please be sure to provide a bag lunch or lunch money for your child each day.



If you choose to purchase meals for your child, school meals continue to be some of the healthiest meal options for students. Our mealtimes feature kid-approved foods and are an important part of the learning day. For the 2023-24 school year, **lunch for elementary school lunches will cost \$2.90 and Northley lunches will cost \$3.20.** The High School is Ala Carte for all meals and will offer meals to those students qualifying for free and reduced eligibility. A la Carte pricing can be found at **pdsd.org/meals**. School menus for all schools can be found at **pdsd.nutrislice.com**.



All school lunch purchases are made through your student's personal meal account which enables you to send a check or cash in advance to credit your child's account. Students access their account by using their student ID# at the lunch checkout line. New students and kindergarten students will be given an ID number on the first day of school. Free or reduced lunch will utilize the same meal account system; funds are credited directly to the student account.

You can access this system online at myschoolbucks.com. You can also add money to your child's account by sending a check made payable to the Penn-Delco School District. The check should be placed in an envelope labeled "lunch" with your child's name and room number. My School Bucks allows parents to view their child's lunch account, add funds (for a small fee), check balances, or view what is being purchased. Students will still have the ability to purchase items in cash as well.

We encourage all families, regardless of income, to complete and submit a short, confidential school meal application prior to the start of the school year to ensure that there are no gaps in meal benefits for students who qualify for free or reduced-price meals. **Parents or guardians can submit this application online at schoolcafe.com** or in person at your child's school office. It's an easy and confidential way to ensure your child stays well-nourished at school.

For families receiving other benefits, such as SNAP or TANF, you may receive notification that your student(s) is/are automatically eligible for free meals and do not need to submit an application. New applications must be submitted every year and previous applications expire after 30 operating days of the new school year. Please go to pdsd.org/meals for complete information on free and reduced-priced meals.



PSSA Assessments

The annual Pennsylvania System School Assessment (PSSA) is a standards-based, criterion-referenced assessment, which provides students, parents, educators and citizens with an understanding of student and school performance related to the attainment of proficiency of the academic standards. These standards in English Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science and Technology identify what a student should know and be able to do at varying grade levels. School districts possess the freedom to design curriculum and instruction to ensure that students meet or exceed the standards' expectations.

Every Pennsylvania student in grades 3 through 8 is assessed in English Language Arts and Math. Every Pennsylvania student in grades 4 and 8 is assessed in science. Individual student scores, provided only to their respective schools, can be used to assist teachers in identifying students who may be in need of additional education supports, and school scores provide information to schools and districts for curriculum and instruction improvement discussions and planning. In compliance with §4.51(a)(4) of the PA School Code, the State Board of Education approved, "specific criteria for advanced, proficient, basic and below basic levels of performance."

PSSA Dates for 2024 are as follows:

- ELA: April 22 26
- Math, Science, and Make-up: April 29 May 10

*Absences during state assessments will not be excused without a medical doctor's note.

Keystone Exams

The Keystone exams meet the federal accountability criteria of ESSA for the high school level. Students must take the Keystone Exams for purposes of federal accountability. Failure to do so will affect a Local Education Agency (LEA) and school's participation rate. The Keystone exams were created to replace the Grade 11 PSSA and serve as one component of Pennsylvania's statewide high school graduation requirement. Keystone Exams help school districts guide students toward meeting state standards. The exams are end-of-course assessments designed to assess proficiency in the subject areas of Algebra I, Literature, and Biology.

The Keystone Testing Window is as follows:

Winter Wave 1: December 4 - 15, 2023

Winter Wave 2: January 3 - 17, 2024

Spring: May 13 - 24, 2024

• Summer: July 29 - August 2, 2024


