



Frequently Asked Questions

- 1) **What can be put in the bin?** – Catalogs, Magazines, Newspapers, Junk Mail, Office Paper, Fax Paper, Shredded Paper Notebooks, Folders. **NO phonebooks. NO CARDBOARD**
 - 2) **When will placement of the bin take place?** – We will place your bin usually within a month of signing up with our program.
 - 3) **Are inside containers provided?** – No, but you can place a box in each room to collect the paper.
 - 4) **Will trash get in the bins?** - The program has been running for over ten years. There is less than 1% trash collected in those bins. In the unlikely event this becomes an issue, we will make you aware of the situation and work with you to resolve it.
 - 5) **When does the payment begin?** - Immediately.
 - 6) **What is the payment?**

0 – 3.99 tons	- \$ 5.00 per ton
4 – 7.99 tons	- \$15.00 per ton
8 or more tons	- \$20.00 per ton
- Example – If 4 tons are recycled, you will earn \$60, but if you recycle 8 tons, then you will earn \$160.
- 7) **When is payment?** - Monthly (Statements/Checks usually arrive around the 15th of the following month.)
 - 8) **How often are the bins emptied?** – **The bins are emptied on a regular schedule.**

Should you fill up prior to your next scheduled pickup, call (215) 509-2220. We will try to schedule an additional pickup, if your weight history warrants an additional pickup. If you repeatedly are filling up prior to your scheduled pickup, we will provide an additional bin, at no charge.
 - 9) **How is the weight of what we have collected determined?** - There is a scale inside of the truck's forklifts that weighs each bin that is picked up.
 - 10) **How much paper does a bin hold?** – A bin holds between 1 to 2 tons of paper.
 - 11) **What is the size of the bin?** – These brand new 7 cubic yard bins have dimensions of approximately 6x6x6. They take up 1 parking spot or can be placed in the grass.
 - 12) **Can I put cereal boxes, chipboard, milk cartons, soda cartons, or food cartons of any kind, in the bin?** NO. We cannot recycle the above items to make newsprint.
